Care Guide



How to care for your PVC Backed Mat

Our PVC Backed Coir Mats are not for external use, rain would pool on the backing causing the coir fibres to rot.

This mat is not supplied with borders and should be fitted into a mat well to support all sides of the mat.

To prolong your PVC Backed Coir Mat, occasionally remove the mat from the mat well and shake to remove the dirt that has built up.



A note about shedding:

- Coir is a natural material it's made from coconuts
- Some shedding of the pile is normal with all coir / coconut mats and will settle
- We have worked hard to find the best quality available with minimal shedding
- Please do not vacuum excessively or pull at loose threads. It is best if you can just give it a shake

Unpacking Your Mat

- Your mat will arrive rolled up, this is to help protect your mat
- 2. Unwrap from the packaging, do not slice it open this may damage it
- Unroll your mat and allow it to lie flat for 24 hours pile side up
- 4. Fit and trim your new PVC Backed Coir Mat into the mat well / recess
