Care and Cleaning



Unpacking Your Mat

- 1. Your mat will arrive rolled up to protect it during delivery
- 2. Unwrap from the packaging, do not slice it open as this may damage the mat
- 3. Unroll your mat and allow it to lie flat for 24 hours pile side up.
- 4. Fit and trim your new Coir Logo Mat into the matwell / recess

How to care for your Coir Logo Mat

Coir Logo Mats are NOT for external use. Rain would pool on the PVC backing which would cause the coir fibres to rot.

As your logo mat will be using coloured coir which is dyes, the rain will cause the colour to run. To best mainatin your mat we do not reccomend placing in direct sunlight as this may fade your logo.

They are not supplied with bordered and are designed to be used in a matwell / recess.

With all types of coir mats, some shedding initially is perfectly normal and will settle over a couple of weeks.

How to clean your Coir Logo Mat

Allow all wet mud to dry on the mat. Then simply brush off.

Depending on the size of your mat occasionally lift it up and give it a shake to dislodge any build up. Alternatively, if your mat is too large and heavy it can be hoovered using a brush attachment.

If Chewing Gum gets lodged on the mat, this can be removed using freeze spray.

Coir is an absorbent material, we do not recommend saturating the mat with water or solvents whilst cleaning the mat. Use dry foam or cleaning powder on the mat.
